ASSOCIATIONS INCORPORATION ACT 1981

Section 5(b)

STATEMENT OF PURPOSES

1. The name of the proposed incorporated association is RICHMOND ROWING CLUB Incorporated.

2. The purposes for which the proposed incorporated association is established are:—

- (a) To advance and promote the sport of Rowing and to provide facilities therefor.
(b) To engender by association a fraternal feeling amongst Rowers and to promote and preserve the best interests and traditions of the sport of rowing;
(c) To foster and preserve the status of the Sport of rowing;
(d) To acquire, take over, carry on, hold and satisfy all of the undertakings, assets and liabilities of the unincorporated body known as the Richmond Rowing Club.
(e) To provide the facilities and environment for social contact between members and their friends and generally afford to them all the usual privileges, benefits and conveniences of a club;
(f) To engage in such other activities, whether of a like nature or not, as may for the time being be permitted by law and determined by the Committee of the Association.
